Katch E-bus scheme extended until end of 2022 – Katch is an electric taxi-bus service sponsored by SCC in partnership with operator [CabsSmart](#); it's trial will be extended until the end of the year. The service launched as a 12-month pilot in E, the extension in time will allow the council to establish a truer picture of demand as bus services strive to recover following the lifting of Covid restrictions.

Suffolk Quiet Lanes - Since its launch nearly 200 parish councils have engaged and there are now more than 350 lanes designated in Suffolk, covering approximately 400 kilometres (248 miles) of country road. All Quiet Lanes are marked with green signs at either end, which clearly show the hierarchy of right of way for people using the road. Residents can use the interactive map on [the Quiet Lanes Suffolk website](#) to find the nearest lanes.

Anglia Green Pylon Project – The consultation period for National Grid's new overhead 400 kV line between Norwich and Tilbury closes on 16th June. The 50m high overhead line would run close to Stowmarket, Wortham and Palgrave. Suffolk County Council has been developing its response and will object to the overland option.
