Minutes of a Cemetery Committee Meeting at the Community Centre on Thursday 13 March 2025 at 7pm

Present: Councillors Cooper (WC) and Pudney (VP). Also in attendance Phil Dyer (PD) (Cemetery Administrator) and Caroline Emeny (Clerk). There were no members of the public present.

- 1. Welcome:** Cllr Pudney, as acting Chair, welcomed all to the meeting.
- 2. Apologies for Absence:** Apologies received and accepted from Cllrs Fausset, Hollowday and Jane McClintock (JMCC).
- 3. Declarations of Interest and Dispensations:** There were no declarations of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests and no requests for dispensations. Councillors were reminded of their obligations under the new Code of Conduct.
- 4. Minutes of the previous meeting:** The minutes of the Cemetery Committee meeting of 12 September 2024 were approved and signed by the Chair.
- 5. To note any matters arising:** No matters arising not covered elsewhere on the agenda.
- 6. Consecration of the new area:** Date agreed as Friday 9th May. Time approx. 10am t.b.c. by Vicar and Bishop. Cllr Pudney and P Dyer will be present. JMCC to be advised. Low key as these are only additions to the area. Note there will be a small fee for the official paperwork, as yet unknown.
- 7. General ongoing maintenance and tasks:** Cemetery looking neat and tidy. All hedges and scrub cut back. K Mobbs (KM) doing a good job. PD will ask KM to start preparing the ground for the new GoR area at the north end of the cemetery so it is a defined area. Will have to consider some form of delineation – PD and CE to look at various options for the next meeting – chain link, picket fence or similar. Area is approx. 25 x 15’.
- 8. Cemetery Administration:** Nothing further to note. Clerk produced income vs expenditure for 24/25 financial year and expressed ongoing gratitude to our monthly donor to cover the grave area grass cutting costs.
- 9. Date of next meeting:** Thursday 11th September 2025 at 7pm in the PDCC lounge t.b.c.
